

# MUSEUM PASSES

---

Museum passes have been made possible by a generous donation by the Friends of the Mountainside Public Library. The library is very grateful to the Friends for their support.

- Passes may be borrowed by Mountainside Public Library cardholders (18 years and older), who are residents of Mountainside, and who are in good standing with no unpaid fines or fees.
- Passes may be kept for up to 3 calendar days including holidays. No renewals are allowed.
- Passes are offered on a first come/first served basis. Holds are not allowed.
- Museum passes must be returned to the circulation desk inside the library. Patrons who return passes to the book drop will be fined.
- Fines and fees:
  - Returned to bookdrop instead of circulation desk: \$5.00
  - Overdue: \$10.00/day. Maximum of \$200.00 (includes days the library is scheduled to be closed, but not unscheduled weather or emergency closures).
  - Missing or damaged museum pass container: \$5.00
  - Damaged pass: Replacement cost plus \$25.00 service fee
  - Lost pass: Replacement cost plus \$25.00 service fee
- Each museum has its own set of rules with regard to facility admission, operations, and the terms and conditions of the pass itself. Library patrons are responsible for verifying and following the requirements and guidelines of the institution they are visiting. The library assumes no responsibility for any misunderstandings that a patron may have regarding the terms and conditions of a particular museum pass.
